


HTTP Requests Per Second

In a microservice ecosystem, services own data, but services also depend on data from other services.










To access this data, the simplest approach is to expose it via APIs. This can quickly lead to messy coupling, bottlenecks and scaling nightmares

















Resource usage as seen by k8s











